



Adrenaline Auto-Injection Module (FA0006)

This course is specifically for qualified First Aiders to assist known employees/customers that suffer from a history of anaphylactic reactions and have been prescribed by a GP with their own Adrenaline Auto Injector

Course Objectives

To provide staff with the training required to act as the nominated First Aider. To be confident to take charge of any first aid arrangements, including looking after the equipment and facilities and calling of the Emergency Services when required, during an incident.

Duration of the Course

Contact time, excluding breaks must be at least 6 hours (1 day). This includes the final assessment.

Validity of the Qualification

2 years (24 months)

Pre-requisites

The candidate must hold a current First Aid Certificate.

What will they learn?

This candidate will be trained to:

- Recognise an allergic reaction
- Manage Anaphylactic Shock
- Manage Anaphylaxis without Shock
- Administer adrenaline by intra-muscular auto-injection
- Be aware of contraindications, side effects and storage implications

Assessment

The qualification is assessed as set out below:

- Continual assessment by the course tutor
- Completion of the portfolio and worksheet to the satisfaction of the course tutor
- Demonstration of the ability to carry out various anaphylactic scenarios in a safe manner.
